Projects may be street planters, tree planting, reintroducing orchards, Open Gardens, the Garden Club, or fun community activities like the Scarecrows, and local groups and individuals provide flowers for the War Memorial from Easter to Armistice Day. The major project for 2018 was the redesign and planting the garden for families of patients in the Critical Care Centre at Hinchingsbrooke Hospital...a wonderful project.

The Greener Streets Project asks people to put out flower pots, carry out litter picks and support a greener way of life as a community...a great initiative to be involved with - whether individually or your entire street !

2018 saw seventeen Open Gardens in the bi-annual festival, the planting of at least twenty more trees and thousands of plants and bulbs to enhance our town, and In Bloom supported the Town Show which was a wonderful community event with a fantastic 642 entries!

You may not realise what Godmanchester in Bloom does for our local community *but* they do it all year round, in all kinds of weather and in doing so they provide us with a greener, brighter, nature-friendly and less polluted environment.
